INDUSTRIAL POLICY:-

- Telangana Government initiated several steps to facilitate the investors by providing investor friendly environment
- Providing uninterrupted 24x7 quality power supply
- Reserving 10% water in all irrigation sources exclusively for industries
- Established a chasing cell at Chief Ministers office headed by a senior IAS Officer, to regularly and effectively monitor progress of various investment proposals made by industrialists.
- State government took special initiatives for improving the Ease of Doing Business

TS-iPASS: -

- Telangana Government enacted unique act called, "Telangana State Industrial Project Approval and Self Certification System (TS-iPASS) Act, 2014" (Act No. 3 of 2014) with effect from 1st February 2015 for speedy processing of applications for issue of various clearances required for setting up of industries at a singly point based on the self certificate provided by the entrepreneur and also to create investor friendly environment in the State of Telangana.
- TS-iPASS provides an end to end online filing of Common Application Form (CAF) for all department approvals including online payment of fees, online tracking application status, receiving queries online, responding to queries online and online receipt of approval.
- Clearances from 22 departments connected for establishing and operation of an Enterprise brought under purview of TS-iPASS.
- Clearances are to be given within the set time limit varying from 1 day to a maximum of 30 days depending upon on the complexity of the approval failing which the approval is said to be deemed.
- The Act empowers the Entrepreneurs with Right to clearances under TS-iPASS, to know the reasons for delay, if any, in getting the clearance within time limits and penalizing the officers responsible for the delay.

- Mega Projects (project with capital investment of Rs. 200 crores & above or more than 1000 employees) will be provided with in-principle approvals within 15 days by TELANGANA STATE WIDE INVESTMENT FACILITATION (T-SWIFT) BOARD under the Chairmanship of the Chief Secretary to Government, to enable implementation of the project swiftly.
- The “ CHASING CELL” Chaired by Addl. Special Chief Secretary to CM at CMO monitors the implementation of TS-iPASS.
- TS-iPASS system has reduced the number of documents to be submitted to each department. Previously applicant was required to submit around 110 documents for all the clearances for establishment of their industry. The number of documents is reduced to 10
- . TS-iPASS being implemented online does not require visit to any department and also reduced the turnaround time for each approval
- Periodical (Fortnightly) review meetings at District Level under Chairmanship of District Collector and DIC is the Nodal Agency.

VI). T-IDEA:- In order to accelerate the process of Industrialization by making various kinds of incentives available to the entrepreneurs, Government of Telangana is providing fiscal benefits under T-IDEA (Telangana State Industrial Development and Entrepreneur advancement). Details mentioned in the Annexure-I enclosed herewith.

Incentives for Micro enterprises will be sanctioned under T-IDEA & T-PRIDE by District Industrial Promotion Committee (DIPC) under the Chairmanship of District Collector after verification of all claim applications by the District Level Scrutiny Committee.

VII). T-PRIDE:- Special / Additional incentives provided for SC & ST owned Enterprises under T-PRIDE (Telangana State Programme for Rapid Incubation of Dalit Entrepreneurs). Details mentioned in the Annexure-II enclosed herewith.

VIII) PMEGP:- Prime Minister's Employment Generation Programme

It is a Government of India sponsored scheme. Implementing agencies are KVIC, KVIB & DIC.

A) Objectives:-

- (i). To generate employment opportunities in rural & urban areas through setting up of new self employment ventures/ projects / micro enterprises.
 - ii) To bring together widely dispersed traditional artisans/ rural & urban unemployed youth and give them self employment opportunities to the extent possible, at their place.
 - iii) To provide continuous & sustainable employment to a large segment of traditional and prospective artisans and rural & urban unemployed youth so as to help arrest migration of rural youth to urban areas.
 - iv) To increase the wage earning capacity of artisans & contribute to increase in the growth rate of rural & urban employment.
- B) Maximum project cost manufacturing sector is Rs. 25.00 Lakhs for manufacturing and Rs. 10.00 Lakhs. for service sectors.
- C) Subsidy is @ 15%, 25% and 35% based on Caste/ Gender/locality (Rural/ Urban)
