SEED VILLAGE PROGRAMME

The main aim of the Seed Village Programme is to supply of quality Foundation/certified seed of notified varieties to the farmers in time at their places at affordable prices.

Pradhan Mantri Krishi Vikas Yojana

The programme is being implemented in all the mandals of the district

The main aim of the scheme is to promote organic cultivation

Under this programme exposure visits/trainings are conducted and inputs distributed like Neem cake, Bio-fertilizers, plastic drums 200 ltrs to selected cluster farmers

NATIONAL FOOD SECURITY MISSION (NFSM)

The main objective is to increase the Production of Pulses through Area expansion

Productivity enhancement in a sustainable manner duly restoring the soil fertility and Productivity at the individual farm level.

Redgram clusters, Intercropping Redgram

Pulses seed, fertilizers and Pesticides supplied on 50% subsidy

FARM MECHANIZATION

The main objective is to achieve completion of farm operations in time with farm equipment thereby to reduce the cost of cultivation and drudgery of the farmer and to increase Productivity thereby improving the economic status of the farmer.

Applications are received in Meeseva

Mandal Level Committee approval for different farm implements to be issued as on date is : Tractor drawn implements, Animal drawn implements, Tarpalins, Taiwan Sprayers, Custom-hiring centres (LPP) (Tractor+Rotovator), on 50% Subsidy,

And for Small Tractors Max subsidy allowed is Rs 1.0 Lakh for general and 95% subsidy to SC/ST farmers on high cost machinery, Small Tractors&CHC-LPP

For below 1 Lakh implements sanction proceedings will be issued by ADAs and for above one lakh implements sanction proceedings will be issued by DAO.

Selection of Custom Hiring Center-Land preparation Package(CHC-LPP) and all CHC's will be finalized by the District level committee chaired by the District Collector, the Proposals approved and submitted by the Mandal level committee(MRO,MDO & MAO) to the District level committee.

For all Custom Hiring centers Bank linkage is mandatory.

NATIONAL MISSION ON OILSEEDS & OIL PALM (NMOOP)

PRADHAN MANTRI KRISHI SINCHAYEE YOJANA (PMKSY)

Objective is the convergence of investments in irrigation at field level.

Ensuring of Integrated development of rainfed areas by adopting soil and water conservation measures, viz., farm ponds, mini percolation tanks, percolation tanks, check dams, bore well recharge structures.
