

**IMPLEMENTATION OF SCHEMS OF
WOMEN,CHILD,DISABLED & SENIOR CITIZEN DEPARTMENT,
NALGONDA**

All the Women Development and Child Welfare activities are being conducted under Project Director, District Women and Child Development Agency, under Chairmanship of the District Collector. The Project Director is responsible for all the Departmental activities and ICDS Projects. The following are ongoing programmes in Nalgonda District.

- Arogyalakshmi Scheme
- Indira Gandhi Matritva Sahayog Yojana Scheme

I. INTEGRATED CHILD DEVELOPMENT SERVICES (I.C.D.S.):

I.C.D.S. Services were started in Nalgonda district in the year 1980-81 in the erstwhile Panchayat Samithi Mothkur. After that the ICDS Services were extended to 15 blocks covering 59 Rural Mandals and 3 Major Municipalities. After Bifurcation of Districts (2093) No.of Anganwadi Centres are functioning under (09) ICDS Projects.

CDPO OFFICES:

In each erstwhile Block one ICDS Project is functioning. The Project is headed by CDPO. The CDPO is in charge of implementation of all ICDS Services, social and empowerment issues of Women and Children in the project area. One supervisor is allotted to each 25 Anganwadi Centers to inspect and guide the Angnawadi Workers.

ICDS SERVICES:

1. Supplementary Nutrition
2. Pre School Education
3. Health Nutrition.
4. Immunization
5. Referral Services
6. Health Checkups.

AROGYA LAXMI SCHEME:

One Full Meal is state government flagship program with aim to improve Nutritional status among Pregnant & Lactating mothers, also to reduce IMR & MMR in the state by providing "One Full Meal".

One Full Meal Programme being implemented in Nalgonda District from 1st January 2015 providing One full meal benefiting **48811** Pregnant & Lactating Mothers, **163778** (6m-6yrs) Children in 59 Mandals of 18 ICDS Projects. After Bifurcation **22276** Pregnant & Lactating Mothers, **71484** (6m-6yrs) Children are benefiting in 31 Mandals of 09 ICDS Projects

Main Components of Arogyalakshmi:

- Every Day One Full meal will be provided to Pregnant women, Lactating Mother and 3 to 6years Children.
- Everyday one boiled Egg and 200ml milk to all Pregnant and Lactating mothers apart from One Full meal
- Weekly 4 boiled Eggs to the Children between 7months to 3 years and everyday Balamrutham
- Everyday one boiled Egg and snacks to the Children between 3 to 6 years apart from One Full meal

Expected outcomes of Arogya Laxmi:

- Enhance the quality and acceptability of nutrition by the pregnant & lactating mothers
- Improve the enrollment of pregnant and lactating mothers at AWCs
- Ensure that pregnant mothers consume 90+ IFA Tablets
- Decrease prevalence of anaemia & under-nutrition among pregnant & lactating mothers
- Ensure that pregnant and lactating mothers receive health checkup and immunization
- Reduce the incidence of low birth babies and malnutrition among children
- Reduce the incidence of Infant Mortality, Child Mortality and Maternal Mortality

INTEGRATED CHILD PROTECTION SCHEME (I.C.P.S.):-

To protect 0 – 18 years age group children in need of care & protection. Integrated scheme to protect children in need of Care & Protection.

- It aims to provide for care and protection of all the children in need of care and protection and children in conflict with law.
- To contribute to the improvements in the wellbeing of children in difficult circumstances
- Reduction of vulnerabilities to situations and actions that lead to abuse, neglect, exploitation, abandonment, and separation of children.

III. CHILDREN HOMES:

Orphan and Semi Orphan girls are admitted in children home and they are provided free boarding and lodging. They are sent for school education. Their admission is continue up to completion of 10th Class. After completion of 10th Class they will be sent to Collegiate Home, Hyderabad for Collage Education. The interested inmates will be join in the Durgabayi Deshmukh Polytechnic College which was functioned under Women and Child Welfare Department. At present Childens Home Miryalaguda and Nalgonda are Functioning in the District

IV. SISHU GRUHA:

Two Shish Gruhas have been functioning in Nalgonda District i.e. Nalgonda and Devarakonda. The Shish Gruha aim is to protect the abandoned, orphan, Relinquished children from the age of 0 to 5 years and adopt to the eligible Proposed Adoptive parents.

Prevention of Domestic Violence Act

- District cell Established to approach by the victim women in Domestic Violence to solve their problems.
- Counseling will be conducted to the Couples where domestic violence is occurred.
- If the Husband not responded to counseling Domestic Violence report will be filed before the Court.
- Immediate residential order will be obtained from the court to reside by the victim in her existing residence.
- Necessary shelter will be provide to the victim, if necessary
- The Domestic Violence should be finalized within 16 days from the date of file the DIR in the Court.

Indira Gandhi Matritva Sahyog Yojana (IGMSY):

This is a new scheme introduced for pregnant and lactating women on pilot basis in 53 selected districts across the country i.e., Nalgonda in Telanagana. Under the Scheme, a cash incentive of Rs.4000/- provided directly to women 19years and above for the first two live births.

Revised of Maternity benefit and conditionality's under IGMSY Scheme accordance with National Food Security Act, 2013. The beneficiary will receive a total cash incentive from Rs.4000/- to Rs.6000/- in (2) Installments effective Implementation from 5th July 2013 between 2nd trimester of pregnancy till infant completes 6 months of age, subject to the fulfillment of specific conditions.

No staff bifurcated from IGMSY Scheme, Hence the IGMSY unit, Nalgonda is Look after the entire Erstwhile Nalgonda district
